

Urgent: Local Residents Targeted in Phone Scam

Triad residents are being targeted in a telephone scam that appears to have started yesterday evening.

Scam artists are identifying themselves as representatives of High Point Bank, or other local banks, and requesting personal information. Both customers and non-customers of the bank have been targeted randomly, indicating that no personal information from the bank has been compromised.

At **High Point Bank**, your safety and security are our #1 priority. Authorities have been notified and we are taking every action to alert our customers of this scam.

For privacy and security reasons High Point Bank will NEVER ask for personal information or account information such as account numbers, debit card numbers, credit card numbers and/or PIN numbers via an email or telephone call. If you receive an email or a phone call asking you to provide sensitive information, DO NOT click on any link and DO NOT enter or give out any personal or account information even if the website, email or phone call appear genuine.
